# ADVISORY CIRCULAR

## DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION

**SUBJECT:** STATUS OF FEDERAL AVIATION REGULATIONS

---

**1. PURPOSE.**

This circular sets forth the current publication status of the Federal Aviation Regulations, any Changes issued to date, and provides a price list and ordering instructions.

**2. CANCELLATION.**

AC 00-44D, dated March 1, 1976, is cancelled.

**3. PRINCIPAL CHANGES.**

Because of the lack of activity in the issuance of Changes to some Parts formerly offered on subscription service, ten Parts have been transferred to a single-sale basis. These Parts are identified by an asterisk in the single-sale list in Appendix 1.

**4. HOW TO ORDER.**

- a. Federal Aviation Regulations are sold by the Superintendent of Documents. Orders for FARs should be sent to the Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402. A check or money order payable to the Superintendent of Documents must be included with the order. The prices of all FAR publications are listed in Appendixes 1 and 2.
- b. Only Parts having frequent Changes are sold on subscription. Parts which are changed less frequently are sold on a single-sale basis and Changes to these Parts are sold separately.
- c. To expedite your order, prepare separate lists for subscription items and single-sale items. Include the Part number, title, and catalog number for each item ordered. Each list should be submitted separately with the correct remittance attached. Your name and address should be placed on each list because subscription and nonsubscription orders are separated for processing when received by the Superintendent of Documents.

**5. FAA INTERNAL DISTRIBUTION.**

Distribution of FARs to FAA personnel is handled through the FAA distribution system based on the survey of requirements made in January 1974. FAA personnel should not order FARs from the Superintendent of Documents.

Copies of Airworthiness Directives that have been issued are for sale in summary form by DOT, FAA Aeronautical Center (consigned agent for Superintendent of Documents), P.O. Box 25461, Oklahoma City, Okla. 73125, Attn: AAC-23.<sup>3</sup> Due to their length, complexity, and frequency of issuance, individual airspace designations, airways descriptions, restricted areas, jet route descriptions, and enroute IFR altitudes are not included in the publication of these basic Parts. Such descriptions are published in the Federal Register and depicted on appropriate aeronautical charts. Aeronautical charts can be obtained from the U.S. Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, Distribution Division (C-44), National Ocean Survey, Riverdale, Maryland 20840.<sup>4</sup> Standard instrument approach procedures are published in the Federal Register by reference to FAA documents which are available for examination in the Rules Dockets (AGC-24) and the National Flight Data Center, FAA Headquarters, Washington, D.C., and at the appropriate FAA Regional Offices and Flight Inspection District Offices. These approach procedures can be obtained from the U.S. Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, Distribution Division (C-44), National Ocean Survey, Riverdale, Maryland 20840.
