Subject: STATUS OF FEDERAL AVIATION REGULATIONS

1. PURPOSE.

This circular provides the public with the current publication status of the Federal Aviation Regulations (FAR), prices, and order forms.

2. CANCELLATION.

AC 00-44DD, dated August 1992, is cancelled.

3. HOW TO ORDER.

- a. Enclosed are two order forms, one for subscription orders and the other for publication orders.
- b. Appendix 1 lists the FAR parts sold as publication orders (single-sale basis); Appendix 2 lists the FAR parts sold as subscription orders. The Special Federal Aviation Regulations (SFAR) which are presently in effect are included in their related FAR parts. The listing of SFARs is included in this Advisory Circular as Appendix 3.
- c. Federal Aviation Regulations are sold by the Superintendent of Documents. FAR parts having frequent changes are sold on subscription (use subscription order form). Parts which are changed less frequently are sold on a single-sale basis and changes to these parts are sold separately (use publication order form).

Copies of Airworthiness Directives that have been issued are for sale in summary form by DOT/FAA, the consigned agent for the Superintendent of Documents, Order from: DOT/FAA, Aeronautical Center, Attn: AAC-23, P.O. Box 25461, Oklahoma City, Okla. 73125. (Vol. I-AD's for Small Aircraft is \$113.00 plus \$28.25 additional for foreign handling. Vol. II-AD's for Large Aircraft is \$130.00 plus \$32.50 additional for foreign handling.)³Due to their length, complexity, and frequency of issuance, individual airspace designations, airways descriptions, restricted areas, jet route descriptions, and IFR altitudes are not included in the publication of these basic Parts. Such descriptions are published in the Federal Register and depicted on appropriate aeronautical charts. Aeronautical charts can be obtained from the U.S. Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, National Ocean Service, Distribution Branch (N/CG33), Riverdale, Maryland 20737.⁴Standard Instrument Approach Procedures are published in the Federal Register by reference to FAA documents which are available for examination in the Rules Docket (AGC-204) and the National Flight Data Center, FAA Headquarters, Washington, D.C., and at the appropriate FAA Regional Offices and Flight Inspection District Offices. These Instrument Approach Procedures Charts can be obtained from the U.S. Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, National Ocean Service, Distribution Branch (N/CG33), Riverdale, Maryland 20737.
