SUBJECT: ANNOUNCEMENT AND INVITATION
FIRST BIENNIAL OPERATIONS REVIEW CONFERENCE


1. PURPOSE. This Advisory Circular announces that the Federal Aviation Administration will convene the First Biennial Operations Review Conference at the Sheraton-National Hotel located at Columbia Pike and Washington Boulevard, Arlington, Virginia 22204, telephone: 703/521-1900. The Sheraton-National Hotel borders Interstate 95 and is about ten minutes travel time from Washington National Airport. The conference dates are December 1 through 5, 1975.
 2. BACKGROUND. The Operations Review Program was established by Notice 75-9 (published in the Federal Register on February 28, 1975; 40 F.R. 8685), and invited interested persons to submit proposals. This invitation culminated in the FAA publishing a set of proposals which were distributed to all persons responding to Notice 75-9. Copies were also made available to other interested persons upon request.
 3. DISCUSSION.
 - a. The Operations Review is aimed at expediting the traditional "one by one" method of amending rules. Necessary regulatory changes will be made in a timely and orderly manner with public and industry participation. Comments on the proposals were requested by August 1, 1975. Most comments were assembled in workbooks which will be distributed in October to persons submitting proposals and to others upon request. These workbooks will be used for discussion by participating persons at the Conference. Parts of the Federal Aviation Regulations (14 CFR) to be discussed are: FAR Parts 25, 43, 63, 65, 91, 105, 121, 123, 127, 133, 135, 137, 143, 145, 147, and 183.
 - b. The Sheraton-National Hotel will make available to conferees all of its 336 guest rooms and suites for the occasion. All meetings will take place in the conference facilities within the hotel. The surrounding area contains other hotels convenient to the meeting

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site, with ample guest rooms available. Parking is available on site for over 500 automobiles. Courtesy limousine service to and from National Airport is provided. Transportation to and from certain other motels/hotels will be arranged for conferees not accommodated at the Sheraton-National. For those who plan to attend, it is suggested that reservations be confirmed at an early date to assure on-site lodging. Guest room reservations should be made by writing directly to the hotel giving the meeting title and dates. (FAA-First Biennial Operations Review Conference, December 1 through 5, 1975.)

- c. There will be no admission fee or other charge to attend and participate in the conference sessions. All scheduled sessions will be open to the public as long as space is available. The FAA cordially invites interested persons to attend.
