SUBJECT: FAA AVIATION REVIEW CONFERENCE

1. **PURPOSE.** This Advisory Circular announces that the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) will hold its Eighth Annual Aviation Review Conference on May 24-26, 1976, at the Sheraton National Motor Hotel, Arlington, Virginia.
2. **BACKGROUND.** The establishment of annual consultative procedures was originally documented in the Federal Register on December 24, 1968 (33 F.R. 19205). The Aviation Review Conference is one of the major consultative planning meetings the FAA holds with its constituency to obtain input on key policy and planning matters affecting the National Aviation System. It is designed to bring together representatives of the aviation community, the general public, state and local governments, and other Federal agencies to review the status of aviation and discuss future plans and policies. Further, the conference provides the stimulus for the other consultative planning meetings held during the year.
3. **DISCUSSION.**
 - a. This year's conference will again feature presentations by government spokespersons on the first day; user presentations on the second day; and on the third day, a joint government/user panel to discuss major issue(s) facing aviation. Details concerning the program have not yet been determined; but, as in the past, the program will be planned jointly by members of the FAA, the aviation community, and the public. Further details concerning the conference will be set forth in the Federal Register and appropriate media. Also, an advance program and preconference registration cards will be mailed to those persons listed on the FAA consultative


