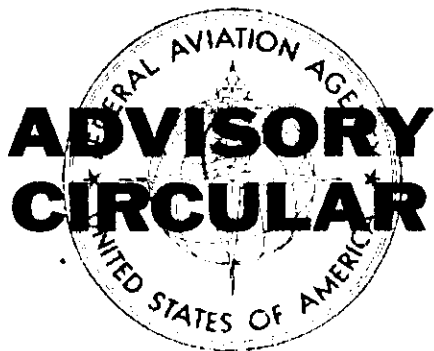

**SUBJECT :** MAINTENANCE SYMPOSIUM - CONTINUED RELIABILITY OF TRANSPORT  
TYPE AIRCRAFT STRUCTURE

The Federal Aviation Agency will hold a symposium at its Headquarters Office, Washington, D.C., November 2, 3, and 4, 1966, to exchange ideas on the general subject of aircraft structure reliability. Specific areas to be discussed will be structural design and testing concepts, structural inspection programs, reliability programs, fatigue and corrosion control, and other subjects related to maintenance of aircraft structure.



Time will be provided for the presentation of papers, and panels may be formed from the attendees for discussion sessions.
