Subject: DESIGNATED U.S. AIRPORTS SERVING
INTERNATIONAL AIR TRAFFIC

Change:

1. PURPOSE. This advisory circular (AC) explains the different categories of U.S. airports designated to serve international air traffic and provides a listing of such airports.

2. CANCELLATION. Advisory Circular 150/5000-5, DESIGNATED U.S. AIRPORTS SERVING INTERNATIONAL AIR TRAFFIC, dated 2/3/83 is cancelled.

3. RELATED READING MATERIAL.

a. The International Flight Information Manual contains up-to-date flight planning information for international airports of entry and landing rights airports. An annual subscription, which includes the basic manual issued annually in April and revised quarterly, may be purchased from the Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402.

b. The following documents contain air navigation plans for U.S. airports designated by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) to serve international operations. These documents may be purchased from:

c. The U.S. Customs Service publishes a booklet entitled "Airports Within the United States--Guidelines for Federal Inspection Services Facilities" which contains guidance material on the physical and facility requirements of airport terminals to accommodate the inspection of international traffic. 4. BACKGROUND.

a. Under Section 1109(b) of the Federal Aviation Act of 1958, the Secretary of the Treasury is authorized to "... designate places in the United States as ports of entry for civil aircraft arriving in the United States from any place outside

thereof and for merchandise carried on such aircraft. This responsibility is assigned to the U.S. Customs Service.

b. Article 68 of the Convention on International Civil Aviation provides for the designation by the signatory Governments (referred to in ICAO as Contracting States) of ". . . the route to be followed within its territory by an international air service and the airports which any such service may use."

5. CATEGORIES OF INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS.


a. Airports of Entry. Airports of entry are those airports which have been designated by the Secretary of the Treasury or Commissioner of Customs as international airports for customs purposes. These airports are open to all international aircraft for entry and clearance purposes without the necessity of obtaining permission. However, advance notice of arrival is required in order that inspectors may be readily available. Designation as an airport of entry follows application by the airport operator and finding by the U.S. Customs Service that the airport will generate sufficient international traffic. An airport of entry must provide adequate space and facilities for Customs and Federal inspection purposes and satisfy certain other requirements established by the U.S. Customs Service.

b. Landing Rights Airports. Landing rights airports are those airports where incoming international flights must obtain prior permission to land and must furnish advance notice of arrival to U.S. Customs. This category of airports includes most of the so-called major U.S. "international airports" (e.g., John F. Kennedy International, Chicago-O'Hare International, Los Angeles International, etc.). Advance notice of arrival may be transmitted via flight plans at those airports where Advise Customs (ADCUS) service is available and such notice is treated as application for permission to land. Customs officers may, at their discretion, grant blanket "landing rights" to individuals or companies at certain airports for a specific period of time, in which case advance notices of arrival are the only requirement. This blanket permission is generally given for scheduled airline flights at busy landing rights airports.

c. ICAO-Designated U.S. Airports Serving International Operations. ICAO airports are those designated under Article 68 of the Convention on International Civil Aviation as airports serving international operations (for traffic or refueling purposes). U.S. airports so designated are identified in ICAO Regional Air Navigation Plans, Documents 8755 and 8733, and include those regularly served by scheduled and nonscheduled international commercial air transport, those designated as alternates, and those used regularly by international general aviation flights. ICAO-designated U.S. airports may not necessarily be airports of entry or landing rights airports as the ICAO designation is independent of any Customs requirements.

6. UNOFFICIALLY NAMED INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS. In addition to the designated international airports discussed above, there are a number of airports in the United States that are not officially so designated but which contain the word "International" within their names. Nothing prohibits such a practice. However, without an official designation, such an airport has no international status.

7. LISTING OF U.S. AIRPORTS SERVING INTERNATIONAL AIR TRAFFIC. Appendix 1 contains a listing of U.S. airports designated as airports of entry or landing rights airports as of January 1985. This listing will be updated infrequently and does not contain current limitations or restrictions on Federal Inspection Services at these locations. Consequently, it should not be used for flight planning. For this purpose, the International Flight Information Manual should be consulted. Appendix 2 contains a listing of U.S. ICAO-designated airports serving international operations which are included in current ICAO Regional Air Navigation Plans (DOC 8755 11th ed. and DOC 8733 12th ed.).
