## ANNOUNCEMENT OF AVAILABILITY

Subject: INTERNATIONAL FIRE SERVICE TRAINING ASSOCIATION'S MANUAL 206, AIRCRAFT FIRE PROTECTION AND RESCUE PROCEDURES (SECOND EDITION, 1978)

1. PURPOSE. This advisory circular explains the nature of the manual and tells how it can be obtained.

## 2. FOCUS.

- a. The International Fire Service Training Association's (IFSTA) Manual 206 was developed to provide information for both airport and structual fire department officers to effectively accomplish the various tasks involved in aircraft firefighting and rescue. It is designed for all types of fire protection organizations and includes the use of both conventional and specialized aircraft firefighting apparatus.
- b. Aircraft fire protection training is extremely valuable to all types and sizes of fire organizations with or without a requirement for providing airfield fire protection. The effectiveness of responding fire crews could very well depend upon their understanding of and training in the procedures and techniques outlined in this manual.
