1. **PURPOSE.** This advisory circular explains the nature of the manual and tells how it can be obtained.

a. It is designed for all types of fire protection organizations and includes the use of both conventional and specialized aircraft firefighting apparatus.

The effectiveness of responding fire crews could very well depend upon their understanding of the training in the procedures and techniques outlined in this manual.
