ANNOUNCEMENT OF AVAILABILITY

Subject: THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION'S STANDARD FOR AIRPORT FIRE FIGHTER PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS (NFPA 1003-1978)

- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. This advisory circular explains the nature of the standard and tells how it can be obtained for use as an airport firefighter program guide.
- 2. <u>FOCUS</u>. This standard was developed by the Fire Service Professional Standards Development Committee for Fire Fighter Qualifications. It specifies in terms of performance objectives the minimum requirements of professional competence required for service as an airport firefighter. It is not the intent of this standard to restrict any jurisdiction from exceeding these minimum requirements.
