Subject: ANNOUNCEMENT OF AVAILABILITY-AIRPORT SELF INSPECTION VIDEOTAPE Date: 11/6/87 Initiated by: AAS-310 AC No: 150/5200-29

Change:

- 1. PURPOSE. This Advisory Circular announces the availability of the Airport Self Inspection videotape and tells how it can be obtained.
- 2. FOCUS. This videotape was developed by the Office of Airport Standards and the Office of Aviation Safety with important input from several of the regions. The video, which is approximately 45 minutes long, is divided into nine subject areas. The subjects are: pavement; safety areas; markings and signs; lighting; navigational aids; obstructions; fuel farms; snow and ice conditions; and construction on airports. These are some of the key areas that should be examined as part of the daily inspection of airport facilities. It is expected that many airport operators will want to use it as part of their training program for airport employees.
