Change:

- 1. PURPOSE.** This advisory circular announces the availability of computer data bank material on airports shown in the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Regional Air Navigation Plans and how it can be obtained.
- 2. CANCELLATION.** Advisory Circular 150/5360-5, Announcement of Availability of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Computer Data Bank Material, dated August 13, 1976, is cancelled.
- 3. GENERAL.** The International Civil Aviation Organization has announced the availability of data on airport characteristics for the airports listed in the five ICAO Regional Air Navigation Plans. The information consists of data in the form of computer printouts or magnetic tapes on runways, taxiways, and obstacles. The subjects cover runway and taxiway strengths, composition, lengths, widths, slopes, elevations, temperatures for each airport, and the location of objects in the approach area of the runway. These data cover all airports by countries listed in the plans.
- 4. HOW TO ORDER.** Copies of the ICAO Airport Characteristics computer data bank material may be obtained by using the order form in appendix 1.

For magnetic tapes please note that tapes 2, 3 and 4 all contain the information on 1, and 2 contains the information on precision approach runways (printed Volume 5). Tape layouts are included with the shipment. Magnetic tapes will be supplied in the following format:

Density = 1 600 bpi Block size = 4 000bytes (characters rounded) or less at purchaser's option
Tracks = 9 Character code set = EBCDIC
Parity = odd

Please advise ICAO if you have different requirements. Tapes will be sent by air, if warranted, at no additional charge.
