**SUBJECT: OFFSHORE AIRPORTS**

1. PURPOSE. This advisory circular announces to the public the availability of a two-volume report on offshore airport planning and construction methods.
2. CANCELLATION. AC 150/5370-5, Offshore Airports, dated December 15, 1969, is cancelled.
3. DESCRIPTION OF THE PUBLICATIONS. Volume One of the two-volume report provides planning guidance to local, state, and regional authorities and interested planners concerned with the development of airports in offshore marine environments. It contains an analysis of planning factors, site selection techniques, and construction methods. Volume Two is an evaluation of the types of development and related offshore construction methods proposed or used at various locations throughout the world.
4. EXPLANATION OF REVISION: This advisory circular has been revised to give the latest instructions on ordering copies of this circular and the offshore airports publications.
