This advisory circular (AC) transmits a 1. schedule of charges for services of Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Flight Standards aviation safety inspectors outside the United States. The methodology for determining these charges and the initial charges developed by this methodology were established by rulemaking action to Federal Aviation Regulation (FAR) Part 187, Docket No. 27809; Notice No. 94-24, Fees for Certification Services and Approvals Performed Outside the United States. rulemaking established that these fees would be published in an advisory circular.

- RELATED FAR SECTIONS. Each charge listed in Appendix 1 2. refers to an FAA activity described in the FAR. Specific FAR reference is listed beside each category of service and charge. Generally, these charges refer to: FAR Part 187, Appendix A - Methodology for Computation of Charges; FAR Parts 61, 63, and 65 - Airman certification; FAR Parts 141, 142, 145, and 147 - Air agency certification; and FAR Part 183 - Designees.
- APPENDIX CHANGES. FAA plans to review the actual costs incurred in the services listed in Appendix 1, at the beginning of each fiscal year, using the same fee methodology described in FAR Part 187, Appendix A. amend the schedule of charges on an annual basis to either increase or decrease fees, as needed. Each amended schedule would be published in the Federal Register and updated in a change to this AC.

Schedule of User Fees for Certification Services and Approvals Performed Outside the United States

ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: This notice informs the public of the effective date of changes to the schedule of user fees for certification services and approvals outside the United States.

The methodology for computing these user fees and the resulting user fee levels were adopted through rulemaking. ection. This rulemaking "Fees for Certification Services and Approvals Performed Outside the United States' Docket No. 27809, Amendment No. 187-5, is published as a final rule in this same part of the Federal Register. and will become effective on May 19, 1995. In connection with its rulemaking initiative, the FAA indicated that it will publish a notice of issuance of Advisory Circular entitled, "Flight Standards Service Schedule of Charges Outside the United States." The Final Rule requires

FAA to publish in the "Notices" section of the Federal Register all changes to the schedule of user fees for certification services and approvals performed outside the United States. This notice is issued in response to that requirement. The new schedule of fees, which will also appear in the Advisory Circular, is presented below.
