

ADVISORY CIRCULAR

SUBJECT : SURPLUS MILITARY AIRCRAFT

1. PURPOSE. This circular sets forth the method of obtaining copies of regulations which might be required for certification of surplus military aircraft.
2. BACKGROUND. New Part 9a of the Civil Air Regulations was issued December 5, 1963, to be effective January 10, 1964. It permits the certification of surplus military aircraft in accordance with regulations which were effective in the past. These regulations, in many cases, are not available from Superintendent of Documents.
3. INFORMATION. A copy of the rules in effect on any date is available for review at each FAA regional headquarters and at the FAA Docket Section, Office of the General Counsel, 800 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20553. Copies of these rules may be obtained from Docket Section upon payment of the appropriate fees prescribed in Part 187 of the Federal Aviation Regulations.
