

SUBJECT : SUMMARY OF SUPPLEMENTAL TYPE CERTIFICATES AND APPROVED REPLACEMENT PARTS

1. PURPOSE. This circular is to advise that the subject summary is no longer for sale by the Superintendent of Documents, United States Government Printing Office.
2. BACKGROUND. In 1962, sale of the subject summary was discontinued by the Government Printing Office; however, supplements are still being regularly printed and issued by the Federal Aviation Agency to add new approvals and to update material in the original publication, which listed:
 - a. Supplemental Type Certificates issued by the Federal Aviation Agency.
 - b. Parts Manufacturer Approvals (FAA-PMA).
 - c. The name and address of the STC or FAA-PMA holders, together with a brief description of the modification or parts.
3. WHERE TO GET INFORMATION. Anyone desiring information concerning Supplemental Type Certificates which have been issued, or replacement and modification parts manufactured under the FAA-PMA system may call or visit the nearest FAA Flight Standards district office or FAA regional office. Inquiries should not be directed to the FAA, Washington, D.C. or to the Government Printing Office.
