ANNOUNCEMENT OF AVAILABILITY

1. PURPOSE. This circular provides information concerning how to obtain the latest edition of subject publication.
2. CANCELLATION. Advisory Circular 21.303-2G, dated October 21, 1988, is canceled.
3. REFERENCES. Federal Aviation Regulation (FAR) 21.303 and Advisory Circular 21.303-1A, Certification Procedures for Products and Parts.
4. BACKGROUND. Parts Manufacturer Approvals are issued to an applicant for the production of modification parts or replacement parts which may be installed on certain type certificated products. Such approvals are subject to the provisions of Part 21, subpart K, of the FAR. These approvals are of interest to mechanics, operators of repair stations, and others engaged in altering, inspecting, or maintaining aircraft.
5. DESCRIPTION. This publication is a listing of parts manufacturer approvals which were valid through August 1992. It is available on 24x, 98-frame microfiche only (nominal size 4x6 inches). Images appear in rows from left to right and top to bottom.
6. HOW TO ORDER. An order form is attached as appendix 1.

7. PRICING INFORMATION. Prices are subject to change, and the prices charged on your order will be those in effect at the time your order is processed.

a. Orders to foreign countries require a special handling charge. The charge is approximately one-fourth of the current selling price of the publication or subscription service ordered and is included in the foreign price. This charge is to cover the special handling required to comply with customs and international mailing regulations.

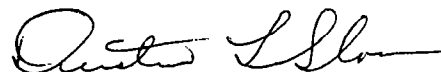
b. Discount policy of the Superintendent of Documents for publications, pamphlets, periodicals, and subscription services is in compliance with Paragraph 1708 of Title 44, U.S. Code, effective January 1, 1974. Orders entered or services commencing after that date are subject to the following discount policy:

(1) A discount of 25 percent will be allowed to bookdealers when the publications or subscription services are mailed, delivered, or forwarded to the dealer's normal place of business.

(2) A discount of 25 percent will be allowed to quantity purchasers (100 or more copies of a single publication or subscription service) when mailed to a single address.

(3) No discounts will be allowed when the publication or subscription service is mailed to a third party (unless in quantities of 100 or more).
