Such approvals are subject to the provisions of Part 21, subpart K, of the Federal Aviation Regulations. These approvals are of interest to mechanics, operators of repair stations, and others engaged in altering, inspecting, or maintaining aircraft.
5. DESCRIPTION. This publication is a listing of parts manufacturer approvals which were valid through November 1984. It is available on 24x, 98 frame microfiche only (nominal size 4x6 inches.) Images appear in rows from left to right and top to bottom.
6. HOW TO ORDER. For your convenience, an order form is attached. If the form has been removed, submit your order as follows:

- b. Send an accompanying check or money order payable to the Superintendent of Documents in the amount indicated. Full payment must accompany each order. C.O.D. orders are not accepted. Foreign money and postage stamps are not acceptable. All remittances must be in U.S. dollars; checks must be drawn on a specific U.S. bank; foreign money orders must be international money orders.

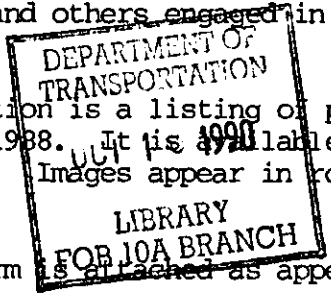
