1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. The purpose of this announcement is to provide notice to users of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) advisory circular (AC) system that Advisory Circular 25-7, Flight Test Guide for Certification of Transport Category Airplanes, dated April 9, 1986, is available as a sale document from the Superintendent of Documents. Although this announcement bears the same number as the AC itself, the actual AC is available only through purchase, as described below.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THE PUBLICATION. Advisory Circular 25-7 provides guidelines for the flight test evaluation of transport category airplanes. The guidelines provide an acceptable means of demonstrating compliance with the applicable airworthiness requirements. The methods and procedures described in the AC have evolved through many years of flight testing of transport category airplanes and, as such, represent current certification practice. They are derived from previous FAA experience in finding compliance with the airworthiness requirements and represent the methods and procedures found to be acceptable by that experience.

3. HOW TO ORDER.
