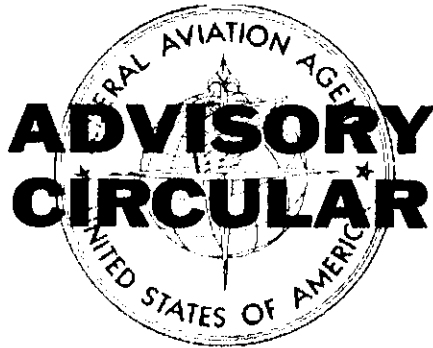

SUBJECT : DISTRIBUTION OF AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVES TO OTHERS THAN AIRCRAFT OWNERS

Cancelled See 39-5

1. **PURPOSE.** This circular is to clarify the procedure for the distribution of airworthiness directives to persons other than aircraft owners.
2. **DISCUSSION.** The airworthiness directive (AD) distribution procedure described in Advisory Circular 39-3 is a new service which will be provided direct to aircraft owners from the Federal Aviation Administration Aircraft Registry in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. In addition, a subscription service for ADs will be provided by the Government Printing Office.

It was planned to begin the subscription service at the same time as the direct distribution to owners. That was not possible, therefore the AD card distribution is being continued. When the subscription service is available, ample notification will be given before the AD cards are discontinued.
