**SUBJECT: DISTRIBUTION OF AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVES**

- 
1. **PURPOSE.** This circular announces an improved distribution service for airworthiness directives.
  2. **CANCELLATION.** Advisory Circular 39-3 dated 3/29/67 and Advisory Circular 39-5 dated 10/3/67 are cancelled.
  3. **DISCUSSION.**
    - a. Purchasers of the Summary of Airworthiness Directives have been receiving supplemental service on a quarterly basis from the U.S. Government Printing Office. Beginning in August 1969, the supplemental service will be on a biweekly basis and distribution will be made direct from the FAA Aeronautical Center in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73125.
    - b. ALL CURRENT SUBSCRIBERS WHO HAVE PURCHASED EITHER VOLUME I OR VOLUME II OF THE SUMMARY OF AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVES WILL RECEIVE THE NEW SERVICE AUTOMATICALLY. New subscribers desiring to receive the biweekly supplements for all aircraft must first purchase the Summary of Airworthiness Directives from:
