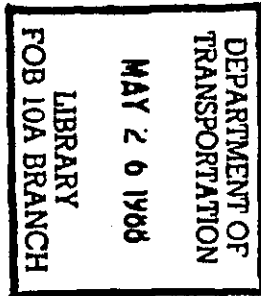

ANNOUNCEMENT OF AVAILABILITY

1. PURPOSE. This circular provides information concerning how to obtain the latest edition of subject publication.
2. CANCELLATION. Advisory Circular 39-6L dated March 14, 1986, is canceled.
3. BACKGROUND. An airworthiness directive (AD) contains information regarding an unsafe condition which exists in an aircraft, aircraft engine, propeller, or appliance when that condition is likely to exist or develop in other products of the same type design. No person may operate a product to which an AD applies, except in accordance with the requirements of the AD. All AD's are summarized and published in both paper copy and microfiche editions.
4. DESCRIPTION OF PAPER COPY EDITION.
 - a. The AD summaries are published in two volumes. The Small Aircraft Volume relates to aircraft of 12,500 pounds or less maximum certificated takeoff weight. The Large Aircraft Volume relates to aircraft of more than 12,500 pounds maximum certificated takeoff weight.
 - b. The AD's applicable to engines, propellers, and other aeronautical products are contained in the respective Small or Large Aircraft Volume.
 - c. Each volume consists of two books. Book 1 contains AD's issued prior to 1971. These AD's will remain in effect until otherwise suspended, revoked, or amended. If an AD from book 1 is amended, it will appear as a supplement to book 2. Once purchased, book 1 should be retained indefinitely. Book 2 contains AD's issued during and after 1971. Biweekly supplements of the AD activity are provided for a 2-year period to update book 2.
 - d. Each book is divided into four major subjects (aircraft, engines, propellers, and appliances). Within each subject, AD's are listed alphabetically by the manufacturers' or type certificate (TC) holders' names. A single index covering both books is provided with book 2. The index is prepared in two parts. The first part is a numerical listing of all AD's. The second part is a subject index listing AD's in the same sequential order in which the books are arranged.

e. Each of the four summary books may be purchased separately. The titles and contents are:

(1) Book 1, Volume I - Summary of Airworthiness Directives for Small Aircraft. (AD's issued prior to 1971.) Published 1982.

(2) Book 2, Small Aircraft Volume, Summary of Airworthiness Directives. (AD's issued during and after 1971.)

(3) Book 1, Volume II - Summary of Airworthiness Directives for Large Aircraft. (AD's issued prior to 1971.) Published 1982.

(4) Book 2, Large Aircraft Volume, Summary of Airworthiness Directives. (AD's issued during and after 1971.)


f. New subscribers for the paper copy edition should be aware that full AD coverage can only be obtained by utilizing both books 1 and 2.

g. Paper copies of book 1 (Volumes I and II) are sold without subscriptions as single sale items. Because of infrequent changes to the older AD's contained in book 1, current subscribers should retain book 1 when reordering book 2.

h. Paper copies of book 2 (Small and Large Aircraft Volumes) are sold by subscription only. Subscription service includes the basic summary book and biweekly supplements for a 2-year period. The AD subscription period begins with June of each even-numbered year and ends with May, 24 months later. The current subscription period extends from June 1988 through May 1990. Subscribers will receive the summary book, index, and back issues of biweekly supplements approximately 6 weeks after receiving the first biweekly issue. The index is updated and reissued each 6 months as part of the book 2 subscription.

5. DESCRIPTION OF MICROFICHE EDITION. The microfiche edition is sold by subscription only. One consolidated file of all four books is prepared annually. Subscription service includes the basic volumes and one year's supplemental information issued biweekly. The price for the microfiche edition changes every year. Biweekly supplements are prepared as separate addendums to the basic file. Each new addendum incorporates all previous biweekly supplements for both Small and Large Aircraft Volumes. A user guide and current index are provided biweekly. Document images appear in rows from left-to-right and top-to-bottom on 24x, 98 frame microfiche (nominal size, 4 X 6 inches).

6. HOW TO ORDER. A price list and ordering instructions are included as appendix 1. An order form is attached as appendix 2.

PRICING INFORMATION

The prices of all U.S. Government publications controlled by the Superintendent of Documents are established by the Public Printer in accordance with Title 44 of the United States Code. Prices are subject to change and the prices charged on your order will be those in effect at the time your order is processed. Subscribers will be notified prior to the expiration of their subscription in ample time to effect a continuity of service.

Orders to foreign countries require a special handling charge. The charge is approximately one-fourth of the current selling price of the subscription service ordered and is included in the foreign subscription price. This charge is to cover the handling required to comply with the customs and international mailing regulations.

The average processing time for subscriptions takes 4 to 6 weeks. Please take this into consideration before making inquiry concerning your order.

Discount policy of the Superintendent of Documents for publications, pamphlets, periodicals, and subscription services is in compliance with paragraph 1708 of Title 44 of the United States Code. Effective January 1, 1974, for orders entered or services commencing after that date, the discount policy is:

A discount of 25 percent will be allowed to bookdealers when the publications or subscription services are mailed, delivered, or forwarded to the dealer's normal place of business.

A discount of 25 percent will be allowed to quantity purchasers (100 or more copies of a single publication or subscription service) when mailed to a single address.

No discounts will be allowed when the publication or subscription service is mailed to a third party unless in quantities of 100 or more.

WHERE TO ORDER

Orders for airworthiness directives should be mailed to the address shown on the order form. In addition to your address, please include the title and price of the subscription together with the item order number.

HOW TO REMIT

REMITTANCE MUST BE IN ADVANCE OF SHIPMENT.

Checks or money orders must be made payable to the FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION. Payment must be included with purchase orders. Credit card orders and c.o.d. orders will NOT be accepted.

Remittances from foreign countries should be made by international money order payable to the FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION or by draft drawn in U.S. dollars on a specific U.S. bank. Foreign money and postage stamps will NOT be accepted.
