SUBJECT: AVAILABILITY OF INDUSTRY DEVELOPED GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE BIENNIAL FLIGHT REVIEW

- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. This advisory circular informs all Federal Aviation Administration certificated pilots and flight instructors of the availability of industry developed guidelines for the conduct of the Biennial Flight Review (BFR).
- 2. BACKCROUND. An ad hoc industry task force was recently formed to develop recommended guidelines relating to the content and conduct of the BFR. This consensus of ideas has now been published by the task force with the recommendation that it be used by flight instructors when conducting the BFR. The FAA would like to call attention to the availability of these guidelines.
