1. **PURPOSE.** Announces the availability of FAA-S-8081-9A, Flight Instructor Practical Test Standards for Instrument (Airplane and Helicopter), from the Superintendent of Documents.
2. **BACKGROUND.** In 1984, a revised system for conducting practical tests for pilot certification was established. In keeping with this concept, a practical test standard has been developed for the certification of airplane and helicopter instrument flight instructors.
3. **GENERAL.** The Flight Instructor Practical Test Standards for Instrument (Airplane and Helicopter) has been published by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to establish the standards for the flight instructor instrument (airplane and helicopter) certification practical test. These standards are to be used by FAA inspectors and designated examiners when conducting the testing of an applicant for instrument flight instructor certification. Instructors and applicants will find these standards helpful in practical test preparation.
