1. PURPOSE. This circular announces the availability to the public of a new publication, Basic Helicopter Handbook.
2. DESCRIPTION OF THE PUBLICATION. This Handbook was prepared as a technical manual for applicants preparing for private, commercial, and flight instructor pilot certificates with a helicopter rating. Currently certificated helicopter flight instructors will also find it valuable as an aid in training students since it gives detailed coverage of helicopter aerodynamics, performance, and flight maneuvers. It does not include material on such things as weather, navigation, radio navigation and communications, use of a computer, use of flight information publications, and pertinent Federal Aviation Regulations.
