

SUBJECT : COMMERCIAL PILOT-AIRPLANE EXAMINATION GUIDE

1. PURPOSE. This circular announces the availability to the public of the Commercial Pilot-Airplane Examination Guide.
2. DESCRIPTION OF THE PUBLICATION. This is a revision of the 1962 Commercial Pilot-Airplane Examination Guide. The guide (1) outlines the scope of the basic aeronautical knowledge requirements for the commercial pilot-airplane rating, and (2) acquaints the applicant with source material that may be used to acquire this basic knowledge. In addition, it contains a sample examination, answers and explanations to these sample examination questions, and many illustrations used in the current commercial pilot-airplane written examinations.
