SUBJECT: GOLD SEAL FLIGHT INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATES

- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. This circular describes the requirements and procedures for the issuance of "Gold Seal" Flight Instructor Certificates to flight instructors with special qualifications and performance records.
- 2. CANCELLATION. Advisory Circular No. 61-35 dated 10/4/66, is canceled.
- 3. QUALIFICATIONS. A flight instructor who meets the following qualifications may apply for a "Gold Seal" certificate at any time. He must have:
 - a. A Commercial Pilot Certificate with an instrument rating, and a Flight Instructor Certificate;
 - A Ground Instructor Certificate with an advanced or instrument ground instructor rating; and
 - c. Within the past 24 months:
 - (1) Attended a flight instructor clinic or refresher course; and either
 - (2) Trained and recommended at least 10 applicants for flight tests, at least 80 percent of whom shall have passed their first tests; or
 - (3) Conducted at least 20 flight tests as a designated examiner, or 20 graduation tests as chief instructor of an approved pilot school course; or
 - (4) A combination of these (Two tests equal one trainee).
- 4. <u>RENEWAL</u>. A Gold Seal Flight Instructor Certificate may be renewed by meeting the requirements prescribed for its original issuance.
