SUBJECT : MECHANIC WRITTEN TEST-EXPIRATION DATE

1. **PURPOSE.** This circular advises persons who have passed sections within the past 24 months of the mechanics written test previously failed, to submit their Form 578A, Report of Written Examination, to FAA, Airman Certification Branch, Federal Aviation Agency, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The form will be reissued showing an expiration date for each section of the test passed.
2. **EXPLANATION.** The expiration date placed on Forms 578A covering the results of the mechanics written test has been 24 months from the date the applicant originally took and passed one or more sections of the test. This date is correct for those applicants who originally passed all sections of the test. However, for those applicants who passed sections of the test on reexamination, the Form 578A should list a separate 24 months expiration date for each of these sections passed.
3. **PROCEDURE.** Starting April 26, 1965, FAA Forms 578A issued for the mechanic written test will show separate expiration dates for each section passed.
