SUBJECT: PETITIONING THE ADMINISTRATOR FOR REVIEW OF HAZARD DETERMINATIONS

- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. To furnish information concerning the submission of petitions to the Administrator for review, extension, or revision of hazard determinations issued by Regional Directors.
- 2. REFERENCE. FAR Part 77 Objects Affecting Navigable Airspace,
 May 1, 1965. Order from the Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government
 Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402, at 35¢ per copy.
- 3. REQUESTING A REVIEW. Section 77.37 of the FAR describes the classes of applicants who may petition for a review, the time limit within which it must be filed, and the form and content. Use of the following guidelines is optional but will permit expeditious handling:
 - a. The petitioner should state why the hazard determination (includes a finding of no hazard), revision, or extension made by the Regional Director should be reviewed. If based on an error in procedure, application of obstruction standards, or in conclusion it should be stated. Notarized affidavits or certificates of service are not necessary.
