SUBJECT: FAA MOTION PICTURE - "CAUTION - WAKE TURBULENCE"

- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. To announce the availability of a new wake turbulence film and encourage its viewing.
- 2. BACKGROUND. Recent in-flight testing has produced significant technical data regarding the trailing vortices generated by heavy jet aircraft. The FAA has incorporated this knowledge into a new movie entitled "Caution Wake Turbulence." The film, which will be of interest to the entire aviation community, is directed primarily to the VFR pilot. Using animation and live footage, which includes actual vortex encounters shot during the flight tests, the characteristics of the vortices are explained and the pilot is taught to envision their location so as to avoid them. In color and with sound, the film runs 16 minutes and replaces the earlier wake turbulence film which was seen by many.
- 3. ACTION. FAA recommends "Caution Wake Turbulence" for viewing by all pilots and will make prints available for use by flying clubs, flight schools, operators, state and local agencies and similar organizations in promotion of flight safety.
