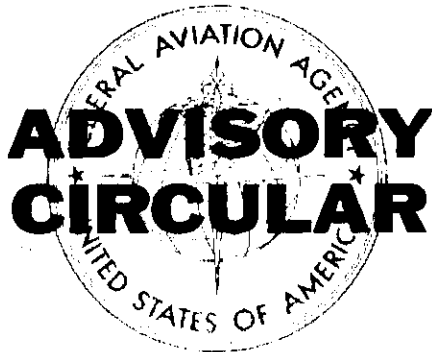

1. PURPOSE. This circular announces the availability to the public of pertinent reference material recommended in preparing for the Air Traffic Control Tower Operator Examination.
 2. PUBLICATION CANCELLED. Air Traffic Control Tower Operator Examination Guide dated September 1961, is cancelled.
 3. REQUIREMENTS. In order to be eligible for an Air Traffic Control Tower Operator Certificate, a person must meet the requirements set forth in Federal Aviation Regulations, Part 65, Certification: Airmen Other Than Flight Crewmembers, Subpart B - Air Traffic Control Tower Operators.
 4. PUBLICATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR ORDERING. The following Federal Aviation Agency publications are recommended study materials in preparing for the Air Traffic Control Tower Operator Examination.
