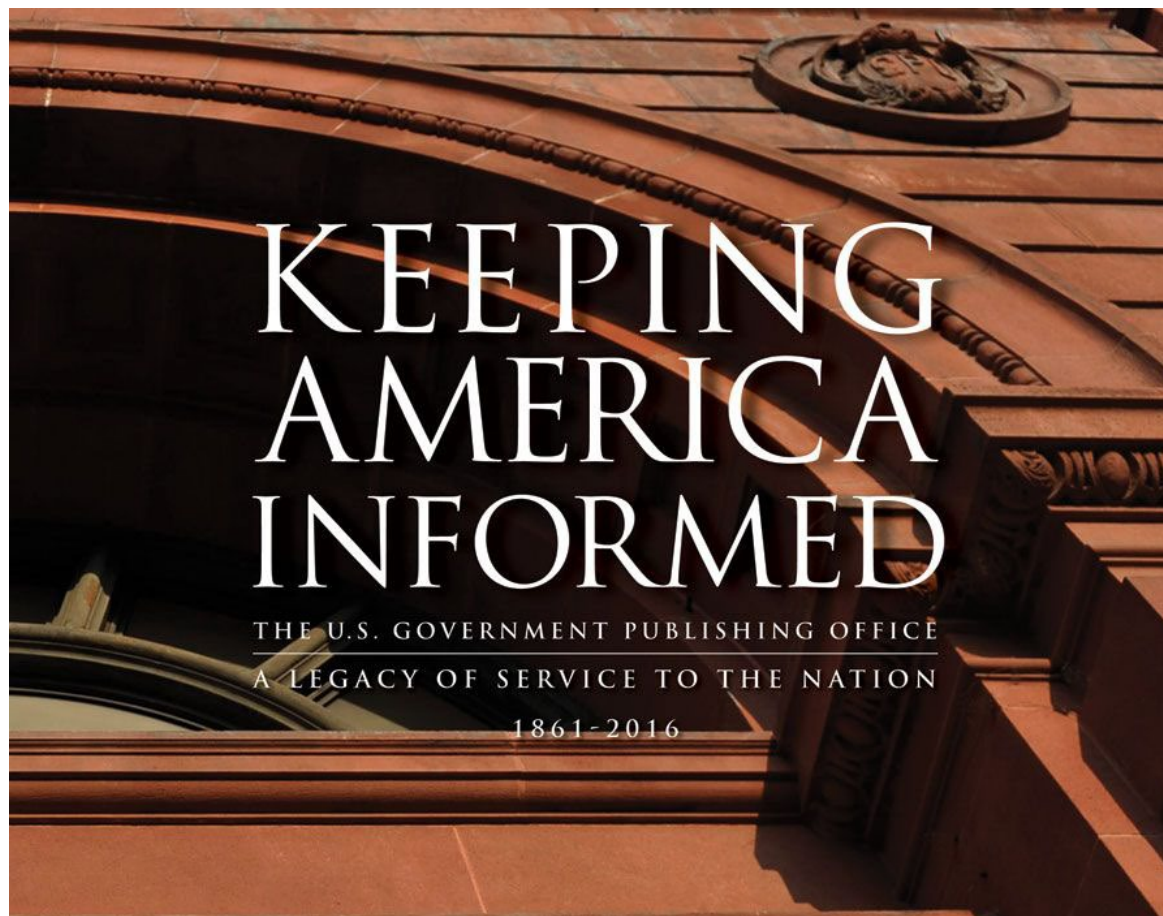

1895 Printing Act





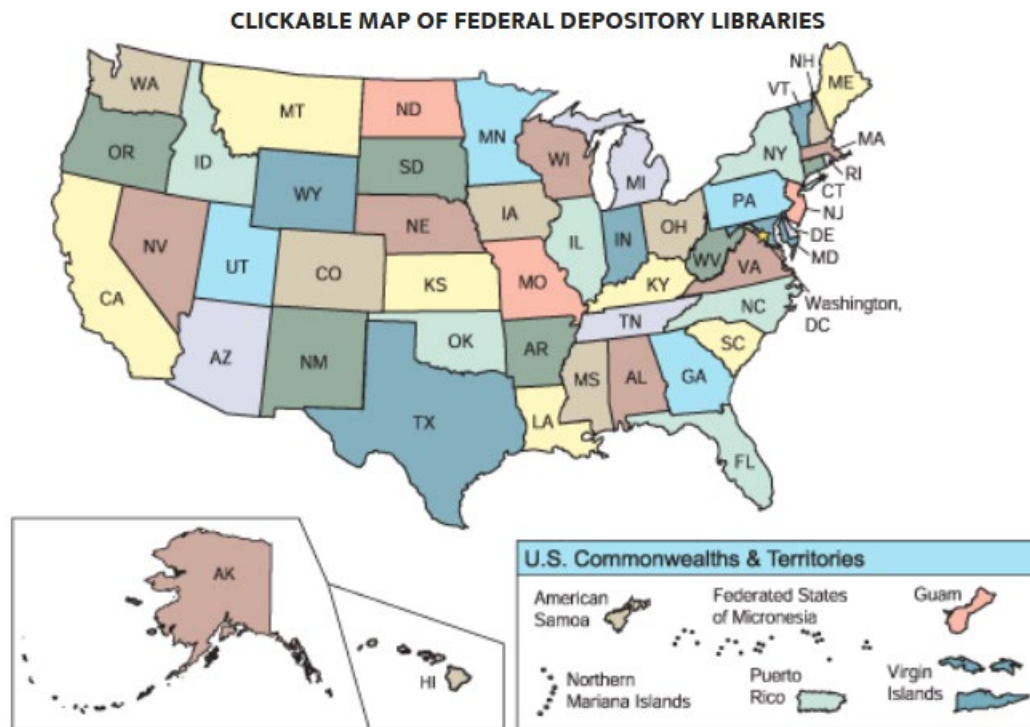
Depository Library Act of 1962

- Two categories of depository libraries:
 - **Regionals:** designation in each state, named by Senators which receive all publications and retain them permanently.
 - **Selective:** chose which documents to receive and discard unwanted documents after a certain period.



FDLP Today

- Over 1,100 federal depository libraries in all 50 states including, DC, and U.S. territories.

Cataloging & Indexing Program

- Mandated by Title 44 of the United States Code.
- Prepare and publish a comprehensive index of every Federal document issued or published by a department, bureau, or office, not confidential in nature, and regardless of format.
- 1895-2004: Monthly Catalog.
- 2004 to today: Catalog of Government Publications (CGP).

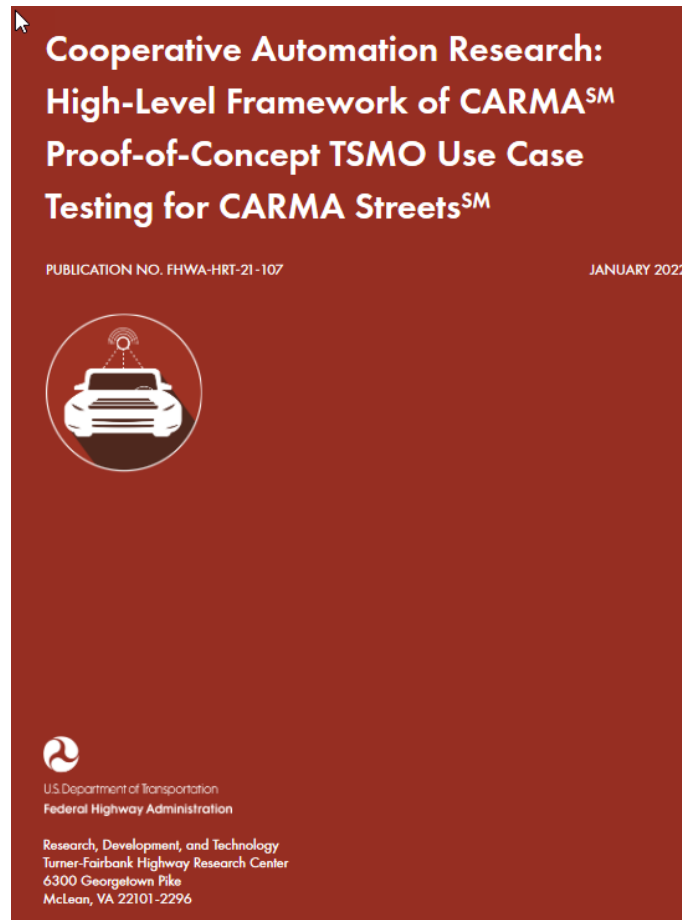
