
- Transportation Research Board annual conference (2022 and 2023), Information and KM Committee meetings

2022 Reference Highlights


- Reference Team Charlotte and Vicki continue to handle most questions from the public (since 2018!) using Springshare's LibAnswers platform

- New database for DOT staff: SAE Mobilus: Contains 42,000+ standards, 143,000+ technical papers, 6,700+ journal articles, magazines and e-books from the Society of Automotive Engineers.

2022 Reference Highlights


- Complete review of FAQs at transportation.libanswers.com
