TPF-5(181) Research Program Management Database Requirements


- Recently completed final phase of a multi-stage pooled fund project
- The original goal was to adapt a research database at Caltrans for use by other states.
- Emphasis shifted to documenting business requirements for research management databases
- Products of this study can be used by agencies seeking to enhance their research databases
- A recommended next step is to create a research project data exchange standard building on information in TRB and FHWA research databases and additional items of interest to DOTs.

State DOT Libraries: A Disappearing Act?

- 52% (27) state DOTs have libraries; 48% do not (25)
- 50% loss of State DOT librarians or libraries or both from 2005 to 2018 (based on TPF(105) library pooled fund member list)

Causes and Effects

Causes

Change in staffing, funding, priorities, upper management support, value of service not well articulated or understood

> Effects on organization

- ➤ Lose centralized KM function, unique or irreplaceable content, ability to deliver knowledge resources to stakeholders and continuity
- How will it create or implement effective information and knowledge management strategies or facilitate knowledge transfer?
- How will it comply with federal mandates for information management and public access?

> Effects on research unit

- Who absorbs the functions and roles?
- Potential to affect quality of research projects and cause duplication of research efforts

Possible Remedies?

- Create practice-ready how-to information for research managers
 - Future peer exchange opportunity?
- ➤ Develop an educational campaign that would inform and teach decision makers what libraries area and what librarians do in 2018
 - Include documentation to combat the belief that "everything's on the Internet"
- Investigate new library models and roles
 - Study opportunity via NCHRP problem statement or library pooled fund group project
 - Look at nomenclature (would other names help us?)
- Measure and communicate the value of library services as value on investment (VOI) instead of return on investment (ROI)
- > Survey research managers to assess their current mindset
 - What are their perceptions of libraries and librarians?
 - How have closed libraries affect their operations or agency?

- Demonstrate that we are following good practices by providing documentary evidence
- Gain independent insights on how to further increase trustworthiness
- Create a benchmark for comparison by identifying the strengths and weaknesses of a repository
- Build user, depositor and funder confidence in the repository
- Create a solid foundation for future certification




