USDOT HOSTS THIRD V2X SUMMIT

October 26, more than 1,000 participants attended USDOT's <u>third Vehicle-to-</u> <u>Everything (V2X) Summit - Saving Lives Through Connectivity</u> at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor and online. DAS Hampshire was joined by FHWA Administrator Bhatt, and NHTSA Acting Administrator Ann Carlson to highlight the <u>FHWA/OST-R draft V2X Deployment Plan</u>, hear from stakeholders on how they plan to accelerate V2X deployment, and host a workshop to refine the strategy to advance connectivity.

DOT BY THE NUMBERS

The total number of trucks operated on U.S. roadways in 2021 was 169.8 million, compared to 85.1 million in 2002, and the annual number of miles driven by these trucks was 1.9 trillion miles, a 70% increase from 1.1 trillion miles in 2002 (via Vehicle Inventory and Use Survey (VIUS) data).
