NEW VOLPE CENTER OPENS DOORS

September 19-U.S. DOT Volpe Center cut the ribbon on its new facility at 220 Binney Street, Cambridge, MA with guests from DOT headquarters, Volpe's property exchange partners, and various media outlets. Speakers included Massachusetts Governor Maura Healy, MIT President Sally Kornbluth, and USDOT Under Secretary Monje.



ICYMI

On September 21, DOT convened the <u>first cohort of SMART grantees</u> at U.S. DOT HQ for a summit designed around the goals of building a peer-learning community, connecting with U.S. DOT leadership, and engaging with SMART staff and share feedback about SMART Grant topics such as performance management.

DOT BY THE NUMBERS

In May 2023, **reporting airlines posted an on-time arrival rate of 81.2%**, up from both 75.7% in April 2023 and 77.2% in May 2022. The year-to-date on-time arrival rate for 2023 is 77.6%.
