STATEMENT PREPARED FOR DELIVERY BY SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION JOHN A. VOLPE UPON ARRIVAL IN GENOA, TUESDAY, OCTOBER 7, 1969

It gives me great pleasure to complete my visit to Italy by coming to the great port city of Genoa. I am particularly glad that the timing of my visit corresponds so closely to the anniversary of one of the most important events in world history — the discovery of the New World by Genoa's most famous son, Christopher Columbus, on October 12, 1492 — 477 years ago this Sunday.
