STATEMENT OF SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION BROCK ADAMS ON THE SIGNING OF A BILATERAL AIR SERVICE PROTOCOL WITH THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY, NOVEMBER 1, 1978

This agreement is another step in the round of bilaterals that have succeeded in opening up a "new Europe" to American travelers.

Only a few years ago London stood alone as the gateway to Europe for air passengers. Now every major city in Germany will potentially be a gateway, and German tourists will find non-stop flights to many American cities not only available but affordable.

We are removing the barriers to international travel one after the other. The results will be bargains for American families and better understanding among nations.
