


FIGURE I - TRAVEL ON ALL RURAL ROADS, BY MONTHS

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


FIGURE 2 - TRAVEL ON ALL RURAL ROADS BY 12-MONTH PERIODS ENDING EACH MONTH, IN VEHICLE-MILES




FIGURE 3 - TRAVEL ON ALL RURAL ROADS
