- I AM DELIGHTED TO BE HERE WITH YOU THIS MORNING, WILLARD.
- * YOU KNOW, THEY SAY NOTHING SUCCEEDS LIKE SUCCESS AND THAT'S WHY I'VE COME TO DESIGNATE YOU AS THE HONORARY CHAIRMAN OF OUR SUMMER SAFETY BELT CAMPAIGN FOR THE SECOND YEAR IN A ROW.
- * IT IS A PLEASURE TO PRESENT YOU WITH THIS PLAQUE ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND WE LOOK FORWARD TO WORKING WITH YOU AGAIN TO REDUCE FATALITIES AND TO PREVENT A LOT OF SERIOUS, DISABLING INJURIES.

- * ONE OF YOUR FAVORITE THINGS TO DO ON THIS SHOW IS TO ANNOUNCE THE BIRTHDAYS OF PEOPLE WHO HAVE REACHED THE AGE OF 100 OR OLDER.

- * I'VE ENJOYED WATCHING YOUR SAFETY BELT MESSAGES DURING THE YEAR AND I KNOW IN TALKING TO PEOPLE AROUND THE COUNTRY, MANY HAVE MENTIONED THAT HEARING WILLARD TALK ABOUT SAFETY BELTS MADE THEM BUCKLE UP.
- * NEW YORK, HOME OF THE "TODAY" SHOW, WAS THE FIRST STATE IN THE NATION TO PASS A MANDATORY SAFETY BELT LAW AND SINCE THAT LAW TOOK EFFECT, TRAFFIC FATALITIES IN THAT STATE HAVE DECLINED BY 27 PERCENT. THAT MEANS THERE ARE 65 PEOPLE IN NEW YORK ALIVE TODAY BECAUSE OF THAT ONE LAW.

 - * WILLARD, WE'RE LOOKING FORWARD TO YOUR HELP ON OUR SAFETY BELT CAMPAIGN THIS SUMMER TO GET OUR MESSAGE OUT TO BUCKLE UP. HUNDREDS OF COMMUNITY SAFETY BELT PROGRAMS ARE GOING ON AROUND THE COUNTRY AND THE PEOPLE INVOLVED WITH THOSE PROGRAMS APPRECIATE YOUR SUPPORT.
 - * AS WE MOVE INTO OUR VACATION PERIOD A LOT OF PEOPLE ARE GOING TO BE INTERESTED IN THE NATIONAL FORECAST AND THEY'LL BE LISTENING TO WILLARD TELLING THEM TO BUCKLE UP IN ALL WEATHER CONDITIONS.
