PRESS AVAILABILITY  
MONTREAL, CANADA  
JUNE 27, 1985

I AM PLEASED TO BE HERE WITH YOU. I CAME HERE TO MONTREAL TODAY NOT ONLY TO OUTLINE MEASURES WE ARE TAKING TO STRENGTHEN THE SECURITY OF AIR TRAVEL BUT TO LISTEN TO DELEGATES TO THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION ORGANIZATION AND SEARCH FOR MORE WAYS WE CAN WORK TOGETHER TO RID INTERNATIONAL AIR TRAVEL OF TERRORISM. I WANT ALSO TO ASSURE ALL AIR TRAVELERS THAT WE ARE TAKING EVERY MEASURE NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN OUR SAFE AIRWAYS AND PROTECT OUR TRAVELERS ABROAD. AND WE WILL NOT REST UNTIL WE RID THE AIRWAYS OF ACTS OF TERRORISM SUCH AS WE HAVE WITNESSED THE PAST FEW DAYS.

THERE ARE A NUMBER OF QUESTIONS TO BE ANSWERED AND I'D APPRECIATE IT IF WE COULD LIMIT THE QUESTIONS TO THOSE BASED ON AVIATION SECURITY AND SAFETY AND OUR MISSION TODAY HERE AT ICAO. I'D BE DELIGHTED TO TAKE ANY QUESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE.
