In a new monthly publication of consumer data, the Civil
Aeronautics Board today released by-carrier breakdowns of more
than 1800 complaints received by its Office of Consumer Affairs
during January and February.

CAB Chairman Secor D. Browne, who created the Consumer office, commented: "The monthly release of complaint tabulations will bring an awareness of the public's problems to the attention of the industry. These figures represent complaints directed to our Office of Consumer Affairs."

When the office was created, Browne said he envisioned it as "an ombudsman type function" and said, "It will ensure better handling of the thousands of communications the Board receives from air transportation users, and should contribute materially to improved service to the public."

The 1,803 complaints compares with 1,385 received in the first two months of 1970. About one-third of these complaints have already been processed and closed, Jack Yohe, director of the office, said.

January, with 1,103 complaints this year as compared with 814 in January, 1970, is normally a high volume month for the receipt of complaints as a result of increased travel during the holiday season. The figures for this

year represent a 35 per cent increase in the number of complaints over the previous year.

Significant increases occurred in two major areas with a 93 per cent increase in complaints about flight irregularities and a 15 per cent increase relating to reservations.

While the total number of complaints received in February were down from January, they were up 50 per cent over February, 1970.

The report will be issued monthly.
