Complaints from airline passengers directed to the Office of Consumer Affairs of the Civil Aeronauties Board continued to mount in April according to the latest monthly consumer complaint report released today.

The office received 671 complaints during the month compared with 546 in April, 1970, for a total thus fair this year of 3-180.

Leading the list of complaints were those concerning delayed flights—83—with lost baggage close behind at 61. The complaints were included in 457 letters sent to the office. Eastern Airlines was the object of the highest number of complaints—with 71° while Continental was the object of the fewest of the trunklines and Pan Am with 8.

Aloha Airlines, an intra-Hawari carrier, had the lowest number of complaints per 100,000 enplanements at 0.00, and Caribair the highest with 17.14 per 100,000 enplanements. Of the domestic trunklines and Pan American, Delta had the lowest per 100,000 enplanements at 1.71 and Pan American the highest at 6.55 per 100,000 enplanements.
