MY CONGRATULATIONS TO THE NATIONAL MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION ON THIS OUTSTANDING PROGRAM HONORING FOUR FOUNDATIONS, ONE OF WHICH IS VERY PROMINENT IN MY SECOND HOME STATE OF KANSAS, FOR THEIR CONTRIBUTIONS TO OUR NATION.
