- -- STAMFORD RAIL STATION (VERY HOT TOPIC IN THE 4TH DISTRICT)
  - -- DOT IS DETERMINED THAT STAMFORD WILL GET A SPARKLING NEW STATION AS ORIGINALLY INTENDED UNDER THE NORTHEAST CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.
