I BELIEVE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BUDGET IS A MODEL OF HOW FEDERAL RESPONSIBILITIES CAN BE MAINTAINED WHILE THE DEFICIT IS REDUCED. WE SIMPLY CAN'T CONTINUE TO DO ALL WE'VE BEEN DOING -- WE'VE HAD TO RETHINK THE FEDERAL ROLE IN TRANSPORTATION POLICY.

THE DEPARTMENT WILL BE ABLE TO FUNCTION IN FISCAL YEAR 1987 WITH A BUDGET REQUEST OF \$21.7 BILLION. THAT'S \$5 BILLION LESS THAN LAST YEAR -- AN ALMOST 20 PERCENT REDUCTION.
