The Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration today announced a \$340,962 supplemental capital grant to the Port Authority of Allegheny County to enable it to complete two bus garages in the Pittsburgh, Pa., Metropolitan area.

UMTA made a \$5,567,780 capital grant to the Port Authority in May, 1965 covering two-thirds of the cost of buying 180 new buses, building 2 operating garages and buying a garage site. The supplemental grant will pay for two-thirds of the cost of unforseen garage construction costs and an unanticipated state sales tax.
