







# Award Categories

#### **Administrator's Superior Achievement Award**

The highest award granted by the FTA Administrator for exemplary achievements that contributed to the accomplishment of the agency's or the Department's mission or programs. The results and manner of performance clearly reflect Agency goals and serve as a model to other FTA employees.

#### **Administrator's Award of Merit**

The second highest award granted by the FTA Administrator that recognizes exceptional achievements which contributed to the accomplishment of DOT's or FTA's mission or programs. The results and manner of performance clearly reflect Agency goals and serve as a model to other FTA employees.

#### **Excellence in Mission Results Award**

This award is granted to any FTA employee whose demonstrated dedication and whose special efforts made significant contributions to FTA's strategic plan goals, mission objectives, and/or major programs.

#### **Ann Linnertz Award For Mission Support**

This award is granted to employees at any grade level and occupation who demonstrate a sustained commitment beyond normal expectations to support the accomplishments of their office's and FTA's mission or program activities, a strong and consistent work ethic, expertise, professionalism, and reliability which are essential to the smooth operation and success of the organization.

#### **Excellence In Management Award**

This award is granted for exemplary supervisory contributions in achieving FTA's mission and goals and management of human resources that are worthy of special recognition.

#### **Excellence In Leadership Award**

This award recognizes sustained contributions based on an individual's effectiveness as a leader – either supervisory or nonsupervisory, the productivity of the individual's program or demonstrated ability to develop the administrative or technical talents of other employees.

#### **Business Process Improvement Award**

This award recognizes individuals, groups, or parts of organizations that can be held up as models for others because they have implemented business practice changes which improved performance or resulted in strategic planning; a focus on business partners, customers, and stakeholders; or improving processes.

#### **Humanitarian Honor Award**

This award will be presented to FTA employees who have displayed courage or exceptional personal responsibility either on or off the job that had a major impact on someone's life. However, these acts should be ones that are not considered to be part of a person's job. This award is designed to give FTA employees an opportunity to publicly recognize a colleague for being exemplary when it comes to helping others in unusual or emergency circumstances.

#### FTA Team Award

This award is designed to recognize groups and teams both internal and those that cross organizational lines for exceptional performance that supports the improvement, reinvention, or reengineering of practices, operations, and customer services and/or emphasizes cooperation, collaboration, and integration.

### Regional Team Excellence In Project/Program Delivery Award

This is a prestigious award designed to recognize regional groups or teams for exceptional performance that supports transit oriented grant programs and reviews, project delivery, and the improvement, reinvention, or reengineering of practices, operations, and customer services.

### Associate Administrator's/ Regional Administrator's Honor

This award is designed to give our Executive Management Team Members an opportunity to select an individual or team that has accomplished exceptional achievements within their Office.




