The United States Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) today announced the award of \$174,728 to the New York State Department of Transportation to support the Unified Work Program for continuing transportation planning in the Rochester area.

UMTA Administrator Frank C. Herringer pointed out that the grant represents a cooperative effort of Federal, State and local governments in intermodal transportation planning. Primary objectives of the study are to conduct organizational activities, land use, population, economic and transportation inventory surveys, development and testing of alternative long-range land use and transportation plans, and subregional studies. In addition, short range activities, goal and objectives development, and technical services will receive support. Included in the subregional studies are planning activities specifically related to the Charlotte-Henrietta Transit Corridor project.

The local one-fifth share of the project cost is being provided by the New York State Department of Transportation.
