The U.S. Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) will present a status report on the dual mode "state-of-the-art," and the results of overall dual mode system design during the Dual Mode Transportation Conference at the Sheraton Park Hotel in Washington, D.C., May 29 and 30.

The conference, of special interest to transportation system designers and technologists, and to urban planners, public officials, and citizen groups is sponsored by the National Academy of Sciences and the National Academy of Engineering (USA) through the Transportation Research Board Committee on New Transportation Systems and Technology.

On display at the two day conference will be scale models of the station designs submitted by Rohr Industries, General Motors Corporation and Transportation Technology, Inc., during the first phase of the UMTA Dual Mode Program. The UMTA Dual Mode Program is designed to apply new technologies to the improvement of existing means of mass transportation. Phase I of the program covers concept and system design.
