The U.S. Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) today announced a grant of \$2,403,360 to the Kansas City Area Transportation Authority (KCATA) of Kansas City, Missouri. The grant will assist in the purchase of 50 new transit buses which will allow KCATA to initiate service on five new routes and improve service on thirteen existing routes.

Since August, 1972, KCATA ridership has been increasing by 2.5 percent every six months. This upswing is due in large part to vigorous service evaluation and marketing programs, and is expected to continue at or exceed the present rate.

Today's grant brings UMTA assistance to KCATA to a total of \$18.5 million.

The local one-fifth share of the present project's total cost is being provided by revenues from a 1 1/2 cent sales tax levied in Missouri.
